What you Should Expect from us | Measures the Church has Taken to Ensure the Safety of Others

Our goal as a church is not to be the first church to open, but rather to be the church that opens correctly.

Double Services

- We will have a limited amount of people allowed in the church (100-125 per service)
- We will have two Sunday morning services, 9:30 am and 11:00 am
- To adhere to the 6 ft social distancing policy, we will reserve every other row and designate one row for the 9 am service and the other for the 11 am service.

Sanitation

- A disinfectant fogger will be set to automatically run every Saturday night to ensure the sanitation of the worship center
- A portable disinfectant fogger will be manually used for smaller spaces to sanitize smaller areas such as nursery, bathrooms, doors, etc.

- Hand sanitizer stations will be put in place throughout the whole building
- There will no longer be a handshaking time during the service to limit physical contact with congregants outside of a family unit
- There will be a designated person in charge of opening the main entrance

Youth

- From the advice of Christian Law Association, we will have what we call “Family Service” for all ages at the worship center
- Children’s Ministry leaders will continue to have teaching times online for kids during the midweek

Giving

- Offering plates will no longer be passed around during the service
- We will have three giving boxes spread throughout the worship center where people can put their tithes, offering, and prayer requests
- We will also have a card reader at the welcome desk (those handling cards must wear gloves)
- We will encourage and emphasize online giving and “Text to Give”

Volunteer Team

- We will not require volunteer teams to wear gloves or masks, unless they are handing out material (notes, coffee, etc.), they must wear gloves
